About Piapot First Nation

Piapot First Nation is located 49 kms northeast of Regina, with a population of approximately 900 members on reserve. Piapot controls lands which are comprised of over 19,000 hectares located throughout Saskatchewan. With an abundance of community programs, we take pride in our Nation, ensuring we maintain our cultural and spiritual teachings, which are of utmost importance on Piapot and at Chief Payepot School. Chief Payepot School is a Pre-kindergarten to 12 school with approximately 290 students and 52 dedicated staff.

About the Opportunity

Piapot First Nation is currently accepting applications for a Vice Principal position to join the Chief Payepot School team on a full-time basis for the upcoming 2022-2023 school year. The Piapot First Nation offers a competitive salary and a benefit package that includes medical, dental, and pension.

Candidates must demonstrate leadership in the following areas:

- A commitment and demonstrated ability to create educational environments that are inclusive and focus on the comprehensive learning needs of all students;
- Implementing Ministry, First Nation's and School goals while establishing a culture of staff professional development directly related to student learning and achievement;
- Demonstrated leadership in learning evidenced by current knowledge of pedagogical best practices and the redesigned curriculum;
- Promoting a comprehensive range of learning opportunities for students, including social responsibility, fine and performing arts, athletics, global citizenship, and technology;
- Implementing innovative practices that lead to student success;
- Demonstrated commitment to personal accountability and professional growth;
- Exceptional interpersonal and communication skills as demonstrated by the ability to listen effectively and work collaboratively;
- Demonstrated ability to build effective teams and a sense of community, and to work effectively in a culturally responsive environment;
- Report to the Ministry of Education regarding school and student data
- Demonstrated ability to plan with the end in mind and to remain focused on agreed-upon goals;

Responsibilities will include, but are not limited to:

- Be able to work collaboratively with Principal.
- Liaising with teachers to maintain curricular, disciplinary, and academic performance standards of students.
- Support school Professional Learning Communities.
- Assist principal with discipline/behavioural strategies.
- Assisting teachers in facilitating conflict resolution between students when necessary.
- Participate in co-curricular school activities and be active in community events
- Maintain appropriate standards of behavior, mutual respect, and safety within the school.
