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VENDOR GUIDELINES – RESPONSIBILITIES & REGULATIONS

By submitting this application, I/we agree to the following:

1. Piapot First Nation is not responsible for any lost, misplaced items or unattended booths
2. No pipes or sacred items are to be sold by vendors
3. Vendors are required to pre-register and pay in advance either by e-transfer, money order, or certified cheque.
4. Full payment of vendor fee is required at time of application
 - a. Vendor spots will not be held or confirmed until full payment is received
 - b. FOOD VENDOR fee is \$600 & ARTS + CRAFTS VENDOR FEE is \$300
5. There are limited number of power outlets on site, vendors are responsible for their own connections and cords to the nearest outlet available
6. Vendor may provide and use their own generator, if needed
7. Vendors must bring their own tables, garbage and recycling bins
 - a. Please place a garbage bin near your own booth to ensure customers have immediate access to dispose of any litter
8. Any cancellation requiring refund must be made 14 days prior to Powwow date
9. Food vendors require Safe Food Handling certificate & must be made available upon request at the event
10. There will be no reimbursements to any vendors due to low sales or weather
11. Please be advised that any failure to comply with these regulations may result in the vendor being asked to leave the powwow site (without reimbursement).
12. When application form is completed along with payment received, vendor will be notified.
13. Piapot First Nation is very cautious of COVID-19 and Food Safety. We ask all vendors to be aware of the health and safety for all customers by sanitizing regularly, wearing gloves and hairnets (if working with food).
14. Prior to event start, Piapot First Nation will provide an onsite and emergency contact list for each vendor
